

## Notice Concerning the Recent Data Breach Experienced by Uber

While the Alabama Public Service Commission exercises some jurisdiction over the operations of global transportation network carrier Uber, the Commission's jurisdiction is limited to matters related to the rates and safety aspects of the services provided by Uber in the State of Alabama. The Commission does not have jurisdiction to delve into the recent data breach experienced by Uber. However, the Commission has been in contact with representatives from Uber regarding the data breach in order to provide assurances for Alabama consumers. The Commission has been assured that the data breach does not involve the Uber app directly.

The Commission has also been advised that any Alabama consumer who has questions or concerns regarding the data incident may follow developments on the matter by going to [uber.com](http://uber.com) and selecting the Company link in the menu. The Newsroom sub-link will provide the most recent updates on how the company is dealing with the breach. In addition, customers may make inquiries to Uber customer service using their Uber app. The Commission has been advised that the customer service representatives are prepared to respond to inquiries regarding the breach.
